Summary of Program:

The intent of this Visiting Professorship program is to engage Family Medicine residents, faculty, psychology fellows and community partners in a three day intensive experience to provide advanced training and faculty development on attitudes, knowledge and skills in integrated primary care (IPC). The goals are to facilitate a unified understanding of IPC concepts, identify perceived barriers to behavioral health integration, pilot methods of curriculum dissemination, and to define and develop our research agenda.

During the sessions:

- All participants will develop a unified understanding of IPC concepts..
- All participants will identify perceived barriers to implementation of behavioral health integration and work toward collaborative solutions.
- Faculty participants will refine curriculum for teaching IPC concepts to residents and engaging all team members in care.
- Participants will explore opportunities for future scholarly activity related to integrated primary care.
