Summary of Program:

Carlos Roberto Jaén, MD PhD, principal investigator of the evaluation of the AAFP's National Demonstration Project (NDP) will spend three days as a visiting professor with Harbor-UCLA Medical Center Department of Family Medicine to help the participants understand the lessons learned from the NDP and to provide guidance and direction for Harbor-UCLA's PCMH project, which will include two ambulatory residency training sites.

Objectives of this professorship program are to:

- Assist the Department of Family Medicine in developing a plan for implementing the PCMH in the ambulatory teaching sites based on lessons learned from the NDP, including a prioritized needs assessment.
- Provide consultation regarding a faculty development curriculum designed to prepare faculty and primary care fellows to lead the PCMH and to teach residents the new model.
- Review the current efforts of the MetroCare Medical Home project to implement the PCMH and provide problem recommendations for solutions regarding obstacles encountered by MetroCare and Los Angeles Department of Health Services leadership.
