Scope of the Project Family Medicine Cares International is seeking family physicians with expertise in Family Medicine and community health, as well as non-medical volunteers with a passion to improve the lives of those in need.

Project Dates February 10 – 17, 2024 (does not include travel dates)

Delegation Costs FMCI delegation scholarship include the following amenities in the Dominican Republic: Group housing, all delegation meals, ground transportation, emergency medical and travel insurance, registration with the Dominican Ministry of Health and the US Embassy, interpreters, tips, taxes, and airfare.

The scholarship costs do not include the following: Single-occupancy accommodations, passport fees, personal travel insurance, personal immunizations, phone or laundry charges, private transportation/ interpreters, personal spending money, and/or items of a purely personal nature.

Parameters of the Trip Scholar is responsible for coordinating his/her own travel between their city of origin and Santo Domingo Las Americas International Airport, Dominican Republic. The applicant may use his/her own travel service or the travel agency AAFP Foundation works with through our Dominican Republic partner to help secure travel arrangements with humanitarian fares.

You must have a passport that is valid through August 2024.

All selected FMCI delegation members will receive an information travel packet from our Dominican Republic partner, One World Surgery, with more detailed information prior to the trip.
